## North Hall



North Hall, an eight-story, L-shaped building, will be built at the northwest corner of the main campus along AU's border with the Wesley Theological Seminary. The building, currently a surface parking lot near the President's Office Building, will accommodate 360 beds for upper classmen. Construction, now in progress, is expected to be completed by August 2013.

During the construction process, there may be temporary inconveniences that occasionally affect our neighbors and the university community. We will always strive to minimize the impact of our construction activity.

## **Rules of Construction**

The university will minimize the impact of construction activity by:

- appointing a university staff liaison to address concerns and answer questions;
- establishing a 24-hour construction contractor telephone contact for reporting problems and establishing a process for timely response;
- conducting preconstruction inspections (including a photographic record) of nearby properties to
  establish a baseline for assessing potential construction-related damage and establishing a process for
  handling damage claims expeditiously and fairly;
- holding a preconstruction community meeting with construction managers to coordinate planned construction activities at least 90 days before construction;
- limiting construction work to 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Mon. through Sat.; interior work not creating an impact on neighboring residences may take place outside these hours; and
- prohibiting construction traffic and construction worker parking on residential streets.
