



INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

Congratulations on your admission to American University. The university is committed to making reasonable accommodations for qualified students with disabilities. In order to promote full participation in academic programs and other campus activities, one of two offices may be able to assist you.

- The **ACADEMIC SUPPORT CENTER (ASC)** works with students with learning disabilities And Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder.
- **DISABILITY SUPPORT SERVICES (DSS)** works with students with physical, medical, sensory, or psychological disabilities.

You are not required to notify the university or any of its offices or personnel of your disability either prior to or subsequent to your admission; however, *if you plan to request accommodations, documentation of your disability must be provided.* To determine your eligibility for accommodations, timely notification assists us in reviewing current and adequate documentation and identifying appropriate accommodations.

The information and records you provide regarding any special need are treated as confidential information under applicable federal and state laws as well as university policies and are only provided to individuals who are required to receive such information on a need-to-know basis.
