

Student Services Update April 2019

Hello Eagle Families. The spring semester is almost over. Here are some topics of interest for April.

Commencement and Ticket pick up :

Because of limited seating in Bender Arena, tickets are required for guest admittance to certain ceremonies. Graduates participating in the ceremony will not need a ticket for themselves. Children under age 3 who will be sitting in an adult's lap during the entire ceremony do not require a ticket. If the child needs a seat of their own, they will require a ticket.

Graduates who do not need all of their tickets and have not promised them to friends or classmates can turn them back in during ticket pick-up for redistribution.

An allotment of six (6) tickets will be distributed to SIS and CAS students who have rented regalia and registered to participate in the ceremony. SIS and CAS students participating in the ceremony will not need a ticket for themselves. Ticket distribution will begin Wednesday, May 1, in AU Central, Asbury Building, and run through Tuesday, May 7, during normal business hours (Wednesday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.; 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday).

Summer Bills:

Payment for students taking summer classes at AU is due May 1. Payment is due at the time of registration for students registering after April 30. The American Payment Plan is not available for summer charges

Housing and Residence Life:

• Returning Student Room Selection for rising sophomores and upper-class students has concluded on March 26, 2019 for all on-campus assignments for the 2019-2020 academic year. We are in the process of confirming a new off-campus housing facility and will then work with on-time applicants to fill these spaces. We will then conduct a wait list process through the summer to fill spaces that open following cancellations. We will continue to communicate

regularly with applicants and welcome students to apply to the wait list through the AU Housing Portal.

- **First-Year Housing Application:** The online application is now available for students who have already submitted a housing deposit with AU Admissions. Housing and Residence Life will also email students inviting them to apply.
- Spring 2019 Closing: It's time to start planning for the end of the semester. Residence halls close on May 8 at noon for students who are not graduating and May 13 at noon for students who are graduating this semester.
 - Mail services: The last day the University will receive packages is May 6. We will distribute packages to residents until noon on May 8⁻ After May 8 all packages will be returned to sender.
- Spring 2019 Maintenance: As Washington, DC warms up in the coming month, we'll be switching from heating to cold air. We will notify students of the specific week of the "seasonal switch-over." As our campus system will be providing either hot or cold air not both it won't always be perfectly in sync with the day's unpredictable weather, so students should be prepared to adjust layers until weather patterns stabilize. Report problems by contacting 2Fix (our facilities team) in one of several ways:
 - Online submit a work order via your AU portal (myAU Home page > Services > 2Fix).
 - Tip: This is best; it allows for most follow-up and accountability.
 - Calling ext. 2359, "2Fix," answered 24/7.
 - Tip: Try to limit this to emergencies.

Orientation for New Students:

Registration for June and July Eagle Summit orientation is now open for Fall 2019 students. Incoming students receive an invitation to register via email sent to their AU email account within 48 hours of deposit. August Eagle Summit registration opens on May 6. AU offers six 2-day summer orientation sessions throughout June and July and two 1-day orientation sessions during All-American Welcome in August. 
Final Exam Schedule:
