Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) – For those students and families receiving federal financial aid (Pell grants and Direct loans) or institutional aid (AU Grants), we wanted to remind you to file your 2018-19 FAFSA by **May 1**st. The FAFSA application will open October 1, 2017, at <u>www.fafsa.ed.gov</u>. As a reminder, students and parents will be using their 2016 federal tax information to complete the 2018-19 FAFSA. <u>Student Account Restrictions</u> – Students with an outstanding fall balance, who are not on a payment plan, will receive notices later this month reminding them of the need to settle their account before spring 2018 registration begins in late October. Students will be given additional notice before a stop is placed on the student's account, which will affect their ability to request transcripts and register for spring semester classes.

Eagle Bucks and Dining Dollars – EagleBucks and Dining Dollars are a convenient, cashless way to make purchases both on campus and at many popular off-campus businesses. Like using a debit card, funds

are deducted as purchases are made. EagleBucks can be used both on and off campus; Dining Dollars can be used at on-campus food locations. Vending machines across campus accept EagleBucks, and EagleBucks are the only form of payment accepted for on-campus laundry.
