

Introduction to the ASAC Instructor Portal

Overview Page


- After logging in to the <u>ASAC Instructor Portal</u>, professors must read and accept the Access Policy.
 - This policy outlines important requirements to ensure all students' rights to privacy and must be accepted before continuing to your portal
- To accept, select "Continue to View Student Accommodations"




After accepting the Access Policy, you will be directed to the Overview Page. This page will be your home page for all future logins, and it displays a list of all students who have notified you of their approved disability-related accommodations for your courses. Each notification in the list is associated with a specific CRN (course registration number), Subject, Course, and Section.



To view a specific student's Faculty Notification Letter, click the blue hyperlink on the left side labeled "View". You will be directed to the online version of the Faculty Notification Letter. This is the same notification that you received via email from the student.



- To view a PDF version of the Faculty Notification Letter, click the blue hyperlink, "PDF."



- In this section, you can also view the status (emailed or read), the date sent, and the date of the last update to their Faculty Notification Letter.




- The last four columns of this section offer a quick view of some accommodations that may be approved for the student.
 - You may need to drag the horizontal scroll bar underneath the listed students to view these options.



- Main Campus faculty- In the navigation menu, click the "Accommodated Testing" link to complete course and test instructions, upload tests, and view upcoming accommodated tests scheduled for your students.
- WCL faculty- WCL is not using this feature, so please disregard.
