- More disclosure would be a gift to scholars



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
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HLOGA

- Senate: one year ban on ALL contacting
- House: one year ban on contacting ONLY prior office







Effect is stronger in the Senate

Effect is more pronounced for majority party, esp. in the Senate

Chamber-wide ban is more effective




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Median lobbyist revenue, by lobbyist background (In 2012 dollars) Active Washington lobbying firm lobbyists only





Percentage of lobbylsts that bring in more than a congressperson's salary Active Washington lobbying firm lobbyists only







The top 10 Congressional offices





Growth of contract lobbylst revenue, 1998-2012




