









# The 2017 Anita F. Alpern Endowed Scholarship

Scholarship recipients for the Anita F. Alpern Scholarship Fund are selected based upon merit, financial need, and commitment to public service. Applicants for the scholarship submit an essay on public service; show an interest in pursuing a public service career; and have a demonstrated record of commitment to public service. Students enrolled in the Masters in Public Administration (MPA) and Key Executive Leadership MPA programs are eligible to apply.

### **Scholarship Amount:**

\$2,500

#### **Eligibility**:

To apply, applicants must be currently enrolled in the Key MPA Program with a cumulative GPA of 3.7 or higher, and receiving little to no financial support from their employer.

## **Application Requirements:**

- In 500 words or less, articulate how your academic skills, experience in public service, and growth in the MPA Program make you a strong candidate. In the header of your statement, include both your name and the scholarship in which you are applying.
- Three letters of recommendation with at least one from a current Key faculty member.
- Submit all application materials to sbrand@american.edu by Monday, January 30, 2017

#### **Review Process:**
