

Do you want to **run for office** some day? Learn the ins and outs of **campaigns and elections**? Become acquainted with **fundraising, communications, and government relations**? Do you want to learn how to **climb the career ladder**? How about **join a growing network** of successful women in the DC area?

If you answered "Yes" to any of these questions, then WeLead is the program for you!

WeLead, a bipartisan leadership training program run by the Women & Politics Institute at American University, works to increase the number of women working in politics and running for office. We empower young women, ignite their passions, and prepare them to succeed in politics and public service. WeLead graduates are employed in the White House and Congress, as well as at campaign consulting firms, lobbying firms, and non-profit organizations.

We target young women and conduct workshops that focus on campaigns and elections, communications and messaging, government relations, fundraising and development, and professional development. These sessions provide WeLeaders with opportunities to network and socialize with each other and with prominent women in politics and public service. WeLeaders will be able to apply practical skills through in-session activities and a guided fundraising project. The Women & Politics Institute is a non-profit organization, and participation in WeLead is free of charge for accepted applicants.

Please note: In order to qualify for participation in the WeLead program, you must be between 21 and 30 years of age. Additionally, you must be available to attend six Saturday trainings (from 10 AM - 3 PM) scheduled over the course of the year. More than one unexcused absence will result in dismissal from the program.
